SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Thame Motor Sport Club & Oxford Motor Club will organise a 12 Car Navigational Rally on Thursday 7th May starting and finishing at The Crown P.H., Chinnor, M.R. 165/755007½.
2. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the RACMSA Ltd., these Supplementary Regulations and any other written instructions that the organisers issue.
3. An MSA Permit has been applied for.
4. The event is open to members of the organising clubs, O.U.M.F., H.R.C.R., Middlesex County Auto Club and Dolphin Motor Club. Membership cards will be inspected at Signing - On.
5. Timetable :

Signing – On from	7.30 p.m.
First Car Starts	8.20 p.m.
6. Ordnance Survey 1: 50000 Map **165 D1** will be required. The route will cover approximately 50 miles.

7. There will be three classes:
Beginner – a crew who have competed on less than 3 events and require marked maps.
Novice - defined as Navigator who has never finished in the top three of a navigational rally.
Expert - All those not classified as above.

Navigation will be nominally easier for the novices. The first beginner will be placed behind the last novice and the first novice behind the last expert in the OVERALL standings.

8. Provisional results will be published at the end of the event and thereafter by email. Protests must be lodged in accordance with G.R. O.5.1.
9. The entry fee will be £ 8.00 which includes refreshments at the finish. Entrants will be supplied with Final Instructions and Time Cards and handouts in sealed envelopes at Signing -On.
10. Marking and penalties will be as per G.R. K.39.2. using the “Marks” system. Modifications will be notified in the Final Instructions.
11. Insurance cover :

Insurance is by the Lockton Motor Sports Club Scheme:
The Club have applied to Lockton for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide Competitors who need to use the Scheme with Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the Event.
The basic rate for the Event (before any loadings) will be £16.



New applicants wishing to use the Scheme must be able to comply with all points of the following Declaration:-

- Over 21 and Held a Full Licence for at least 6 months
- Not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years
- No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence
- No physical or mental disabilities
- No other material facts

If you are able to comply with all points above all you will need to do is sign the Lockton signing on form, at signing on for the event. - **No Letter of Acceptance will be issued.**

If you are unable to comply with any of above points you will need to complete a Declaration Form. Either contact the Organiser for one or go direct to Lockton several days prior to the Event to allow sufficient time for it to be returned or faxed to the Insurers for a letter of Acceptance to be issued.
