

Dolphin Motor Club (Newbury) Ltd.,

Spring Rally, 19th March 2010.

- 1. The Dolphin Motor Club will organise a 12 Car navigation rally, on 19th March 2010, starting at Tot Hill Services 458 ½ 612 and finishing at the Craven Arms 427 648. Permit No:- 57326
- 2. The event is open to all members of the organising club, Oxford Motor Club, OUMDC, Basingstoke Motor Club, Hart Motor Club & Wessex Motor Club.
- 3. All competitors must produce a valid club card.
- 4. The program of the event will be.

Scrutineering and signing on will start at 7.15 PM. All competitors and marshals must be signed on by 7.50 PM

A meeting of all drivers and navigators will take place at 7.50 PM in the car park (weather permitting).

ALL MUST ATTEND.

- 5. Cars will start at one minute intervals; first car will start at 8.01 PM. Total mileage will be approximately 55 miles on maps 174 edition D1 and 185 edition D2.
- 6. The event will consist of three classes as follows:
- I. Experts any crew whose navigator has won a 12-car rally or an award on a higher status road rally.
- II. Novices any crew (excluding Beginners) whose navigator has not won a 12-car, or competed on a higher status road rally.
- III. Beginners any crew whose navigator has competed in no more that 3 previous 12-cars, and has not finished in the top 3 thereof.
- 7. The entry list opens on publication of this notification and closes at 7.45 PM. on the 19th March 2010.
- 8. The entry fee for this event is £5.00. For Dolphin club members & £8.00 to others. Cheques to be made out to The Dolphin Motor Club (Newbury) Ltd.,

9. Insurance is by the Lockton Motor Sports Club Scheme:

The Club have applied to Lockton for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide Competitors who need to use the Scheme with Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the Event.

The basic rate for the Event (before any loadings) will be £16.28

New applicants wishing to use the Scheme must be able to comply with all points of the following Declaration:-

- Over 21 and Held a Full Licence for at least 6 months
- Not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years
- No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence
- No physical or mental disabilities
- No other material facts

If you are able to comply with all points above all you will need to do is simply sign on the Lockton signing on form, for Insurance, at signing on for the event. - No Letter of Acceptance will be issued.

If you are unable to comply with any of above points you will need to complete a Declaration Form. Either contact the Organiser for one or go direct to Lockton several days prior to the Event to allow sufficient time for it to be returned or faxed to the Insurers for a letter of Acceptance to be issued.



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10. Competitors will be supplied with any black spots quiet zones and give ways at signing on.

11. PENALITIES: Marking will be as follows.

1) Not reporting at a TC. 1 Fail.

2) Not reporting at an MTC. Exclusion.

3) Not reporting at or providing proof of visiting a route check/passage control

or entering or leaving it in the wrong direction. 10 Marks.

4) Early arrival at any time control. 2 Marks/Min.

5) Late arrival at any time control. 1 Mark/Min.

6) Opening any sealed envelope containing route information. 1 Fail each.

7) Exceeding 30 minutes accumulative lateness at any TC. 1 Fail each.

8) Exceeding Makeup. 1 Fail each.

9) Recording an incorrect code at a PC. 10 Marks.

10) Recording a dummy PC. 10 Marks.

11) Entering or leaving any time control in the wrong direction. 1 Fail.

12) Any of the following.

(a) Entering a black spot.

- (b) Not giving way at a stop junction.
- (c) Not driving as instructed in a quite zone.
- (d) Not taking note of an instruction from an official.
- (e) Excessive vehicle noise, Excessive speed or driving

Likely to bring motor sport into disrepute. Exclusion.

- 12. The organisers may re-classify a Time Control into a Passage Control, or cancel a particular section if they deem it fairer to do so, Force Majeure notwithstanding.
- 13. Competitors will be required to stop at all standing giveway and stop signs, as well as at any giveway junctions issued. This means that all four, road wheels must stop rotating and the vehicle must cease forward motion behind the appropriate line or lines on the road at that point.
- 14. To classify as a finisher, competitors must visit both MCs, all within the maximum lateness shown on the time card, and without having suffered the penalty of exclusion.
- 15. Any ties for position will be resolved by reference to 'furthest cleanest'.
- 16. Provisional results will be published as soon after the end of the event as possible. Results will be made final as soon as possible after the provisional results are published and printed in the next Dolphin M C newsletter.
