Supplementary Regulations

Dolphin Motor Club is promoting a Twelve Car Navigational Rally on Friday, 1st February 2008. It is a 'Clubsport' event open only to the members of Dolphin MC, Oxford MC, Guildford MC, CSMA, Farnborough DMC, Hart MC and Basingstoke MC.

All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card at signing-on.

MSA permit: 44840

- 1 The event is a round of the Dolphin Motor Club Twelve Car Rally Championship.
- 2 The organiser, to whom entries must be sent, is:

- 3 Entry is fee £6 for Dolphin Members and £8 for anyone else. Entries open on publication of these reg's and close at 7.15pm on 1st February.
- 4 For any one not a member of the organising or invited clubs. DMC (1 year) membership if required is available from the Organiser at £15.
- 5 Insurance is by the Lockton Motor Sports Club Scheme:

The Club have applied to Lockton for a Blanket Cover Note under the above scheme. This will provide Competitors who need to use the Scheme with Third Party Cover necessary to meet RTA requirements on the Road Sections of the Event.

The basic rate for the Event (before any loadings) will be £ 15.50

All new applicants wishing to use the Scheme must be able to comply with all points of the following Declaration:-

- Over 21 and Held a Full Licence for at least 6 months
- Not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years
- No more than a maximum of 6 speeding points on licence
- No physical or mental disabilities
- No other material facts

If you are able to comply with all points above all you will need to do is simply sign on the Lockton signing on form, for Insurance, at signing on for the event. - **No Letter of Acceptance will be issued.**

If you are unable to comply with any of above points you will need to complete a Declaration Form. Either contact the Organiser for one or go direct to Lockton 14 days prior to the Event to allow sufficient time for it to be returned or faxed to the Insurers for a letter of Acceptance to be issued.

- 6 Signing-on and scrutineering will be from 19:00 hrs; any competitor not signed on by 19:40 may be excluded and, if excluded, will forfeit any fees. A competitor's briefing will take place at 19:50. Entrants will be supplied with Final Instructions, Time Cards etc, at signing on.
- 7 Cars will start at one-minute intervals; Car 1 starting at 20:01 hrs.
- 8 The maximum entry for the meeting is twelve. There are three classes:
 - Experts who will receive route instructions concealed inside sealed envelopes.
 - Novices who will receive easier route instructions.
 - Beginners who will receive very easy route instructions.
- 9 Results will be declared following the end of the event and, thereafter, written up in the Dolphin Motor Club Magazine. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with MSA General Regulations Section C(d).
- 10 The results will be determined using the penalty points system outlined below (this is a modified version of Rules in Section H Chart 84):
 - 1 Mark for every minute arriving at a Time Control late.
 - 2 Marks for every minute arriving at a Time Control early.
 - 15 Marks for every missed Passage Check or Route Check (code board).
 - 1 Fail for every missed Time Control or wrong approach to a Time Control.
 - 1 Fail for every route instruction envelope opened before its correct Time Control.
 - 1 Fail for arriving Outside Total Lateness (OTL) at any Time Control.
 - The Organiser reserves the right to use any means necessary to separate ties.
- 11 Competitors are reminded of Rules H Chart 84 as follows:
 - (m) Excessive speed or driving likely to bring motor sport into disrepute – exclusion
 - (n) Excessive sound – exclusion from the event until satisfactory repairs have been made.
 - (q) Not stopping before entering any road protected by a Stop or Give-Way sign – exclusion.
- 12 Lighting – a maximum of four forward facing beams may be used during the event. Auxiliary Spotlights must be wired so they go out on dip. The organiser's decision will be final on this matter.
- 13 A copy of the MSA Yearbook will be available for inspection at the start and the finish of the event along with all other paperwork on request.
- 14 The route is approximately 60 miles and takes place on OS Maps 174 and 185 latest editions.
